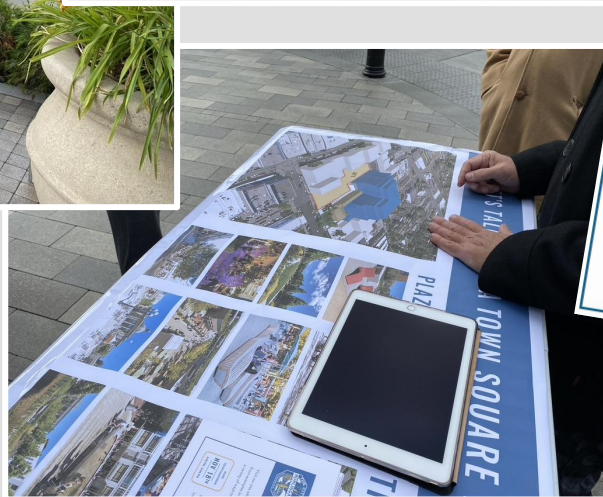

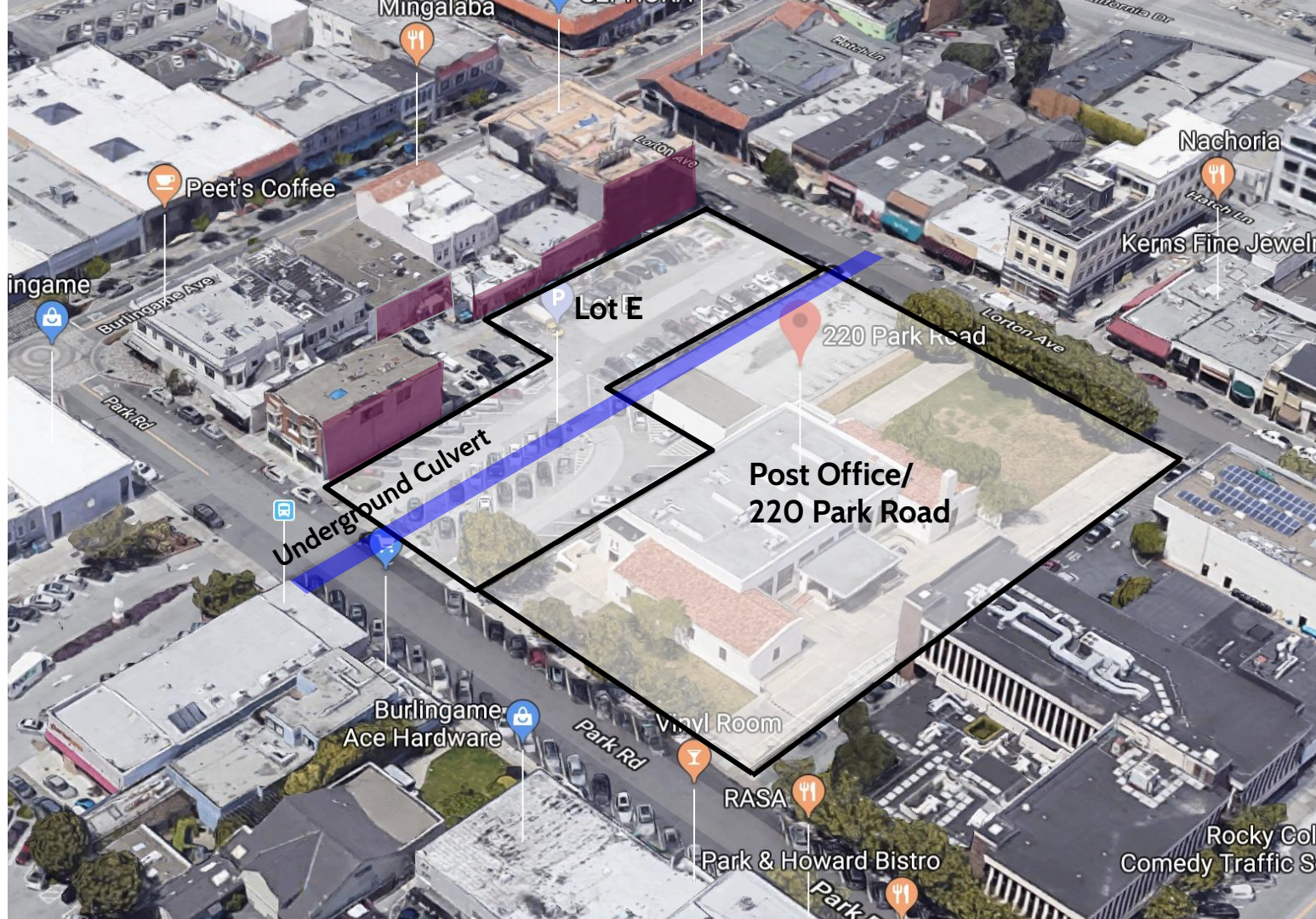

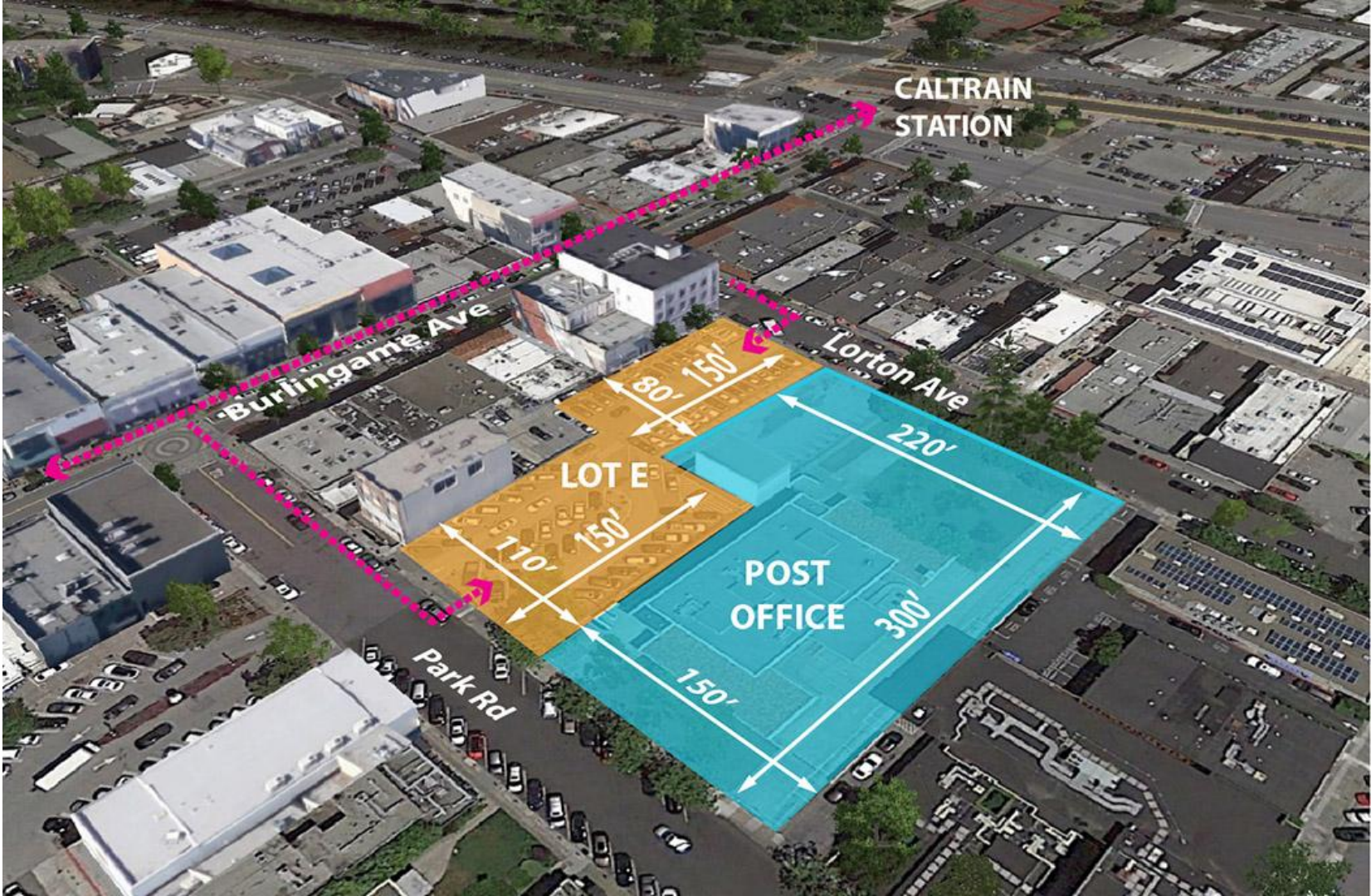

- 162 net new parking spaces in the new city parking structure on Lorton south of Howard Ave



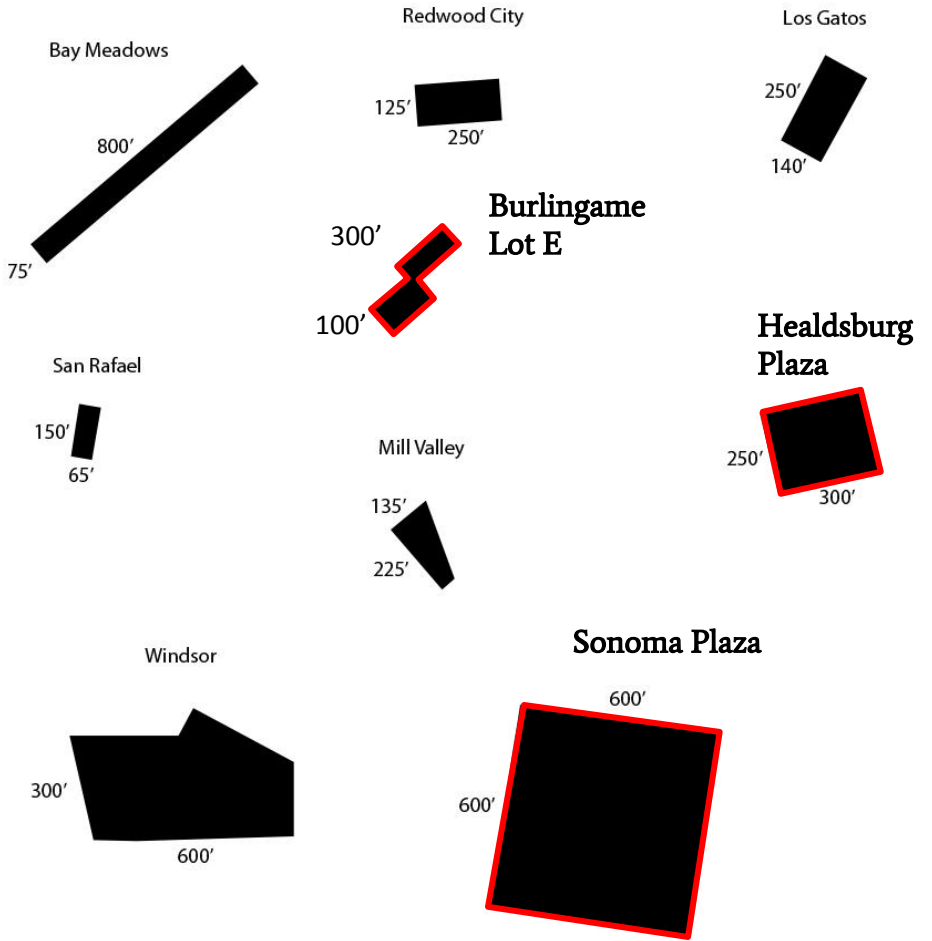

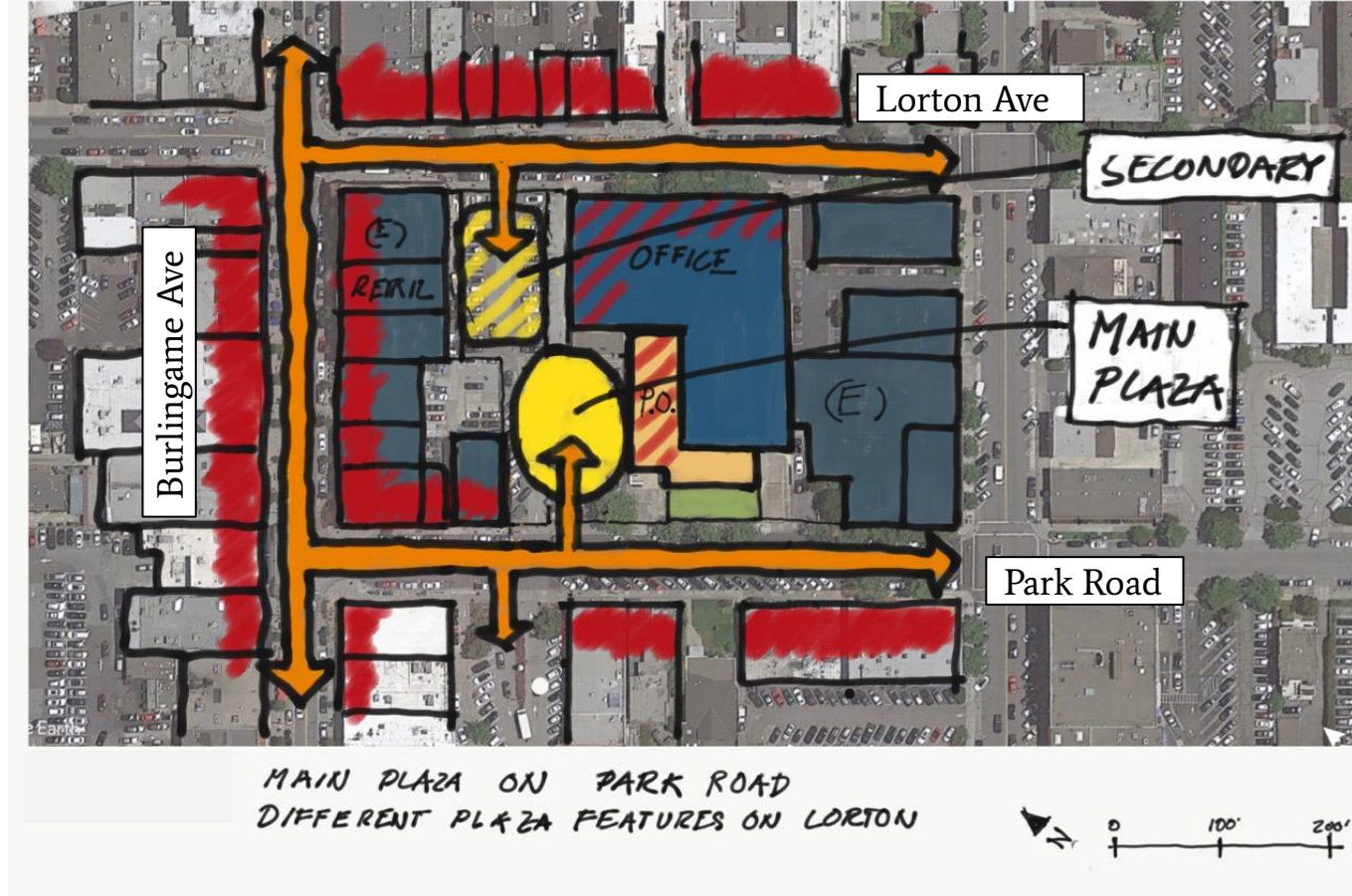

- Main square fronting on Lorton Avenue

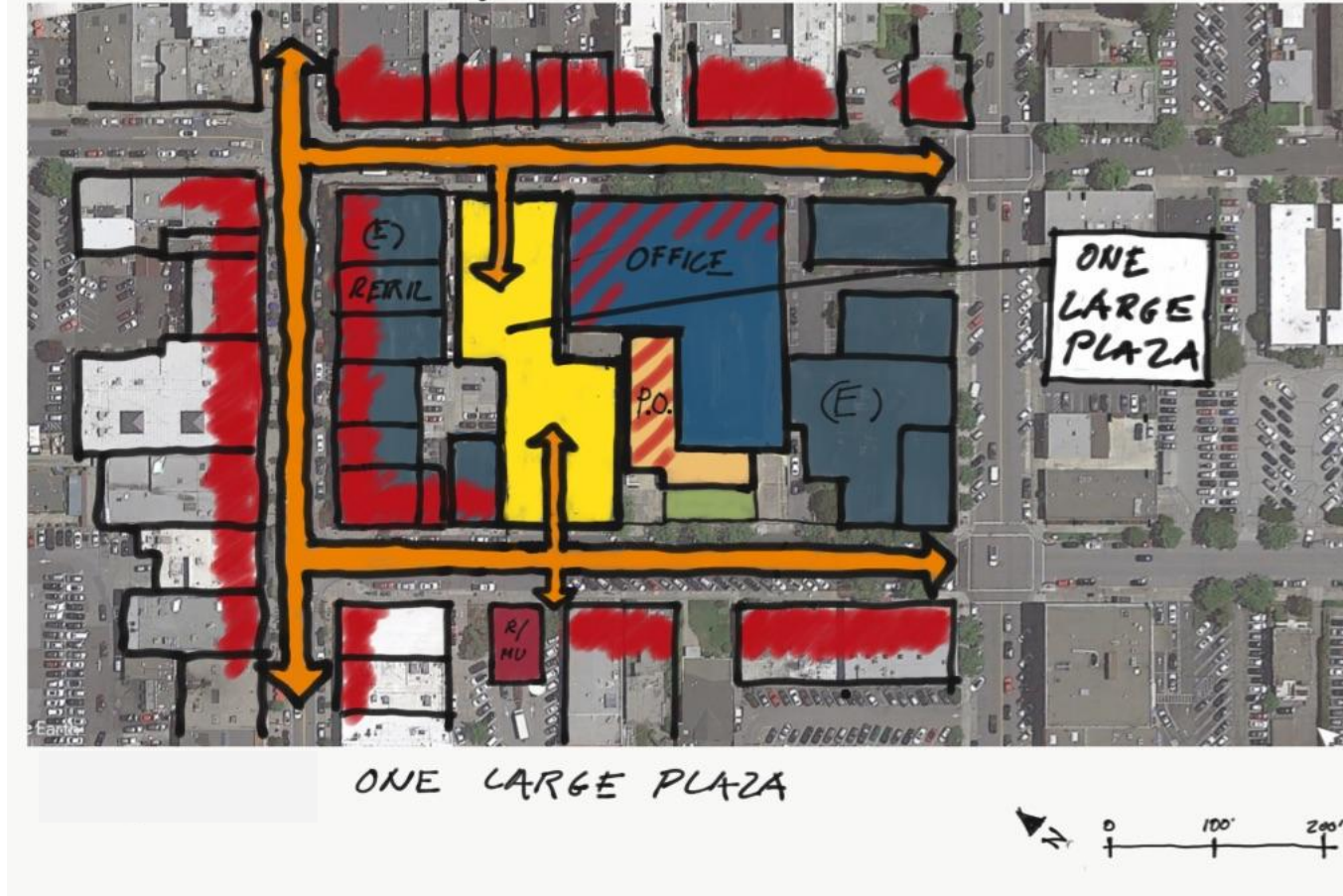

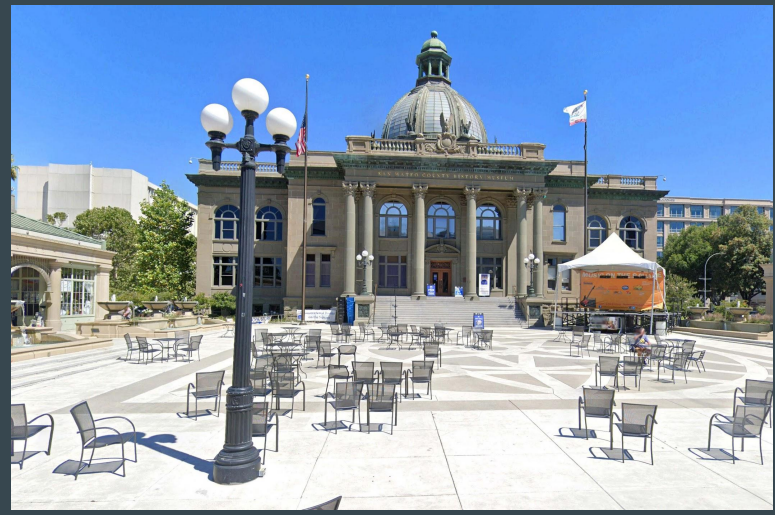
