



Background, Purpose, and Need


- Occidental Avenue and Ralston Avenue intersection was identified in the 2020 Updated Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan as a high priority location recommended for improvements.
- Neighborhood has raised concerns about rolling stops and pedestrian safety at these intersections, and high speeds along Occidental.
- Need to improve geometrics at the intersections and reduce excessive speeds to improve safety for vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians.
- City was successful in acquiring \$420,000 from 2022 Cycle 6 Measure A and W Bicycle and Pedestrian Program to address these issues.

Existing Condition (Ralston)




Comments from First Meeting

- Concerns of speeding on Occidental
- Poor visibility and rolling through stop signs at Ralston and Chapin
- Consider stop signs at Ralston
- Consider cheaper solutions such as repainting crosswalks and stop bars
- Concerns about parking at intersections in advance of crosswalks
- Concerns about proposed use of orange plastic posts
- Design should fit the neighborhoods
- Requests for striped/high-visibility crosswalks
- Support for and against the use of speed humps on Occidental




