NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The **2024 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. 86720**, will be receiving bids for this project via PB System™, a fully automated web-based vendor and bid management system. Prospective bidders should visit <https://pbsystem.planetbids.com/portal/46106/portal-home> to register, download bid documents, and submit their bid. All bids must be submitted to PB System™ before 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, May 14, 2024. Bid results will be publicly opened and read at 2:30 P.M. on Tuesday, May 14, 2024. Those submitting a bid will be sent an email with the conference call information for the bid opening. Additionally, the bid results will be displayed in the PB System™ after they are publicly read.

The work consists of street base failure and resurfacing on various city streets and two city parking lots within the City limits. Several different types of activities will be used including asphalt concrete “dig-out” repairs, asphalt concrete overlay, storm drain improvements, concrete curbs, concrete base repair, conduit for future EV chargers, valley gutters, surface milling, traffic markings and striping, traffic control, and other related works.

Engineer’s Estimate for the work is approximately \$2,150,000.

Special Provisions, Specifications and Plans, including prevailing wage rates to be paid in compliance with Section 1773.2 of the California Labor Code and related provisions, may be inspected in the office of the City Engineer during normal working hours at City Hall, 501 Primrose Road, Burlingame, California. Prevailing wage rates are also available for review at the State of California Department of Industrial Relations’ Web site.

A pre-bid meeting will not be held for this project.

Any questions regarding this project should be submitted through the online Q&A feature of PB System™. Questions can be submitted until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, May 8, 2024. Answer will be made available via PB System™.

The Contractor shall possess a Class A license prior to submitting a bid.

No contractors and subcontractor may be listed on the bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.5(a)].

All contractors and subcontractors will be required to furnish electronic certified payroll records directly to the Labor Commissioner (aka Division of Labor Standards Enforcement).

All contractors and subcontractors will be required to submit a California Air Resources Board (CARB) compliance statement with the bid proposal. Failure to submit this statement may result in a nonresponsive bid.

All work specified in this project, shall include the base bid, and shall be completed within **75 of Working Days (WD) (seventy five working days)** from date of the Notice to Proceed.
