

Neighborhood Stormdrain Projects

Neighborhood Projects are miscellaneous Citywide residential area projects. The projects consist of replacing the deteriorated collection system and installing new catch basins, curbs and gutters, and debris basins to intercept debris that often causes obstructions in the storm drain system. The project will improve stormwater collection and reduce flooding damage to the streets. City staff have identified and prioritized approximately 100 neighborhood project locations throughout the City.

Projects Completed

- Phase #1 was completed by Fermin Sierra Construction, Inc. in April, 2011.
- Phase #2 was completed by Stoloski & Gonzalez Construction Company in June 2011.
- Phase #3 was completed by W.R. Forde Associates in January 2012.
- Phase #4 was completed by Stoloski & Gonzalez in January 2013.
- Phase #5 was completed by Stoloski & Gonzalez in October 2013.
- Phase #6 was completed by D&D Pipelines, Inc. in September 2014.
- Phase #7 was completed by D&D Pipelines, Inc. in December 2015.
