

PROPER BULKY ITEM & HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

BURLINGAME MUNICIPAL CODE 8.6.020 PROHIBITS THE DUMPING OF DEBRIS, BULKY ITEMS, AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ON PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY. YOU MAY BE FINED UP TO \$500 PER DAY FOR ILLEGAL DUMPING.

REMEMBER, PLACING AN ITEM BY THE CURB WITH A "FREE" SIGN IS ILLEGAL DUMPING.

GOT BULKY ITEMS?

Items such as mattresses, appliances, furniture, TVs, etc.

Sell them on Craigslist, Facebook Marketplace, or NextDoor.

Donate them to a local thrift store, (e.g., Goodwill, Pick of the Litter). Call the store ahead of time to confirm they will accept the item(s).

Schedule a free pickup through Recology. Each property is entitled to two free pickups a year. If you live in a multifamily complex, contact your property manager and/or owner. For more information, visit www.recolgy.com/sanmateo
