

## **Burlingame Parks & Recreation Commission**

At their monthly meetings, currently held at 7pm on the third Thursday of each month, the Parks and Recreation Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council, City Manager, and Parks and Recreation Director in providing general oversight, input, and recommended direction for the City's recreation programs and park facilities.

The Commission provides their recommendations and input on policies that staff then applies to the variety of programs and facilities available to the public. These might include:

- 1 – Athletic Field Uses
- 2 – Aquatic Center Operations
- 3 – Reservable Picnic Areas
- 4 – Jump House Uses in Public Parks
- 5 – Off Leash Dog Areas in Public Parks
- 6 – Allowable Signage in Public Parks
- 7 – Policy Implementation or Updates

In addition, the Commission is asked to weigh in on Department budget requests, park planning and projects, contracted operations such as with the Burlingame Golf Center, contracts with the local School Districts, as well as evaluating City Recreation Classes, Special Events, and Programs.
